CURRICULUM

The Academy uses the English and Mathematics National Curriculum guidance and level expectations as the basis for the planning and development of English and Mathematics across the school. From September 2014 The New Primary Curriculum will be in place.

In Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2, classes are set in English and Maths according to the children's ability. For all other subjects children are taught in mixed ability classes with close attention being given to the individual needs of each child. Within a class, groups are formed so that children of similar ability in particular subjects can be taught as a unit.

The teaching staff work in year group teaching teams. Year group programmes of study are drawn up to utilise the talents, expertise and experience of all team members and other support staff who may be involved. The New Curriculum is designed to meet the individual needs and stages of development of the children. Children work in a variety of ways, small groups, class based activities as well as individually, to maximise their learning opportunities.
