These activities are to be completed every day from Monday to Friday. Please can you also continue to work on the activities that were sent home in the original learning pack also.

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue to practise writing your name using the template sent home from Nursery. If your child is able to confidently do this, then allow them to write their name without any prompts. | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Using objects from around your house and using the number cards in your packs. On Monday can you find one object and put the number 1 next to it, for example 1 book, 1 cushion, 1 of your favourite toys. Then using the number formation sheet for support, can you write the number 1? On Tuesday, complete the same activity but using the number 2, Wednesday using number 3, Thursday using number 4 and finally Friday number 5 |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue to work on your number recognition especially numbers 1-5. If your child is able to confidently do this, then introduce numbers 6-10 and beyond if needed! | |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you find 3 objects in the house that are round? You can even try and draw them too! If that's too easy, then find objects that are square shaped and draw them also! To push your child even further extend the shape hunt into a triangle or rectangle! | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Design your own easter egg! You can either print a template off for your child to colour in or if you are feeling really artistic, you can help your child colour/paint a hard-boiled egg!• https://simplemomproject.com/easter-egg-templates/ |
