Can you practise the chest push? Hold a ball to your chest and push it out - How far can you make it go?




## Nursery


## Year 5

Due to their dazzling and unusual appearance, one of the most absorbing aspects of the mummification process is the use of canopic jars. Each jar served to insulate a particular organ of the body due to the fact that the Egyptians believed that it was significant to preserve the body, therefore it would be fit to enter the afterlife. The fundamental organs of the body were removed and taken out, (excluding the heart) then they would be put in four canopic jars, each symbolizing the god of the four gods of Henu. The lungs were slowly removed and put in a jar which represented the God Hapi. Child had the head...
